The program launches this summer beginning in June 2025. The fee is \$75 a month, which includes one scheduled group meeting and up to two individual sessions you schedule each month at your convenience. We are available to you whenever you need support in moving forward in this exciting new chapter of life, and there are no additional charges beyond the monthly fee.

We explore what it's like to end a long-term career in education and move into the next phase of life, we investigate how retired educators can influence education even after being out of the classroom, and most importantly, we strategize how you can best put your specific talents to use in a post-retirement fashion.
